

Please leave the following items at home:

Cell phones, iPods, MP3s, game systems; fireworks, lighters and matches; pocketknives; laser pointers; non-prescription medications; inappropriate clothing; food, candy, snacks. **Your child's safety and welfare are important to us. We have a zero tolerance policy for controlled substances or firearms on any of our three sites.**

Other Helpful Information

Physicals and Immunizations: State Law no longer requires physicals unless there are current health conditions or activity limitations noted on the health form. If all immunizations are current, you may indicate that on the health form and sign.

Roommates: We will do our best to form cabins based on congregational attendance. Your camper may request up to 2 roommates of the same grade level. Requests should be made 2 weeks prior to your camper's arrival at camp (if not already listed on your camper's registration form) by emailing kpeterston@gllm.org or calling 320-796-2181.

Insurance: GLLM carries secondary accident insurance on campers. In case of an accident or injury, your insurance will be the primary coverage.

Medications: GLLM requires that all medications be checked in during registration with our Health Aide. Campers need not bring over-the-counter medications as we keep standard medications on hand. Your camper will receive each dose of prescription and non-prescription medication (with permission on camper's Health Form) from our Health Aide.

Canteen: Snacks range in price from \$1.00-\$2.00; clothing & trinkets range from \$3.00-\$50.00. Our canteen uses a banking system. This means that each camper will deposit money at the canteen during registration. This money will be available to them whenever the canteen is open for business. Campers will receive the remainder of their money in an envelope at the end of their camp week.
